Please note that your program registration will expire on **June 27, 2022** and we recommend that you submit a registration renewal prior to the date.

As a contractor with an active FAA-mandated testing program, you must implement your program no later than the date you start performing safety-sensitive functions for a part 119 certificate holder with authority to operate under parts 121 and/or 135, or an air tour operator defined in § 91.147.
